SPEEDY CAMPING AND PARKING

INFO - RULES - REGULATIONS

- Reservations are accepted for the Dream, Kings Royal, and World 100.
- Campsite fees: Reserved sites are \$40.00 with a required reservation fee of \$13.00 Non-reserved sites \$45.00
- Campsite area is 30'x 45', one camping unit and one vehicle is allowed per site. There is an additional fee if adding a tent.
- Reserved campsites become available on Sunday of the week that the event falls within.
- A "Speedy Camping & Parking Permit" will be issued upon arrival and must be prominently displayed in the windshield at all times.
- Car parking passes are available, designated car parking area is Row 4. Parking pass must be prominently displayed in windshield at all times.
- Available on site services...
 - ~Hot Showers ~Portable water ~Ice and Firewood ~Garbage pick-up
 - ~Free trash bags ~Sanitation service for black/gray water disposal
 - ~Restrooms located throughout the campground ~Site mowing
- Designated quiet time- race days- 1 hr after last race until 7 a.m. on non-race days 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. We request that this time is respected.
- Campfires are permitted, must be contained, large fires are NOT allowed nor will they be tolerated. NO
 digging into ground for campfire. Do not use wood containing nails.
- Golf carts and UTVs are allowed. They must be registered and display a 2013 Golf Cart Permit.
 Registration is available at both entrances. Other rules and regulations apply.
- Under extreme wet conditions golf carts/UTVs will not be permitted to operate. Unnecessary
 driving/cruising campground with vehicles will not be permitted. Please keep on main driveways.
- All pets must be registered with campground and leashed at all times please clean up after them.
- Fireworks are not allowed nor will they be tolerated. Fireworks are prohibited and all users are punishable by Federal and State Laws.
- Campground Housekeeping...In our effort to move toward more "recycling" and to make the clean up more efficient we are asking you to:
 - ~ Pick up and dispose of yellow "caution tape" that outlines your camping area.
 - ~ Bag aluminum cans in a separate bag from everything else.
 - ~ Bag or burn all other rubbish. Do not put non-burnable into campfire.
 - ~ Trash bags are available at both campground entrances and are free for the asking.
- Reserved site/sites must be occupied by 12 noon on Friday of the scheduled event or your site/sites may be sold to another customer. If you are unable to comply with this deadline please contact us.
- You are responsible for the camping fee for the site/sites you reserve. If you will not be
 using a site/sites please contact us prior to arrival.
- Campsite Reservation Policy Speedy does NOT send renewal notices. It is your responsibility to renew
 the reservation from year to year. Timelines will be announced. Please keep in mind that as long as the
 reservation fee is paid from one year to the next those same site/sites will be held for you until the
 following year.
